



ANTI-AGING SKIN CARE

This course has two parts: Level I and Level II, which can be taken in any order. ANTI-AGING SKIN CARE LEVEL I

Relaxation face yoga for stress caused wrinkles smoothing versus Botox. How to take care of skin on a daily and weekly basis. Aging Prevention: how to make skin glow and avoid aging.
