### Training Information

#### Classroom Course:

You are required to receive a minimum 20 hours of classroom training, obtain First Aid Certification (not included in the 20 hours), and pass all exams. After completion of the classroom course, qualified trainees will begin behind-the wheel training.

#### Behind-The-Wheel Training:

Trainee must be in possession of a valid Class B California Commercial Learners Permit with Passenger, School Bus and Air Brakes Endorsements by the California Department of Motor Vehicles prior to the start of the behind-the-wheel portion of the training program.

Behind the wheel training is a minimum of 20 hours of one-on-one training time with your instructor. Your training schedule will be dependent on the schedule of your instructor, but effort will be made to reasonably accommodate your schedule as much as possible. After your behind the wheel training is complete you will be taken by your instructor to CHP for the final exam.
